Instructions for Administering Assessments

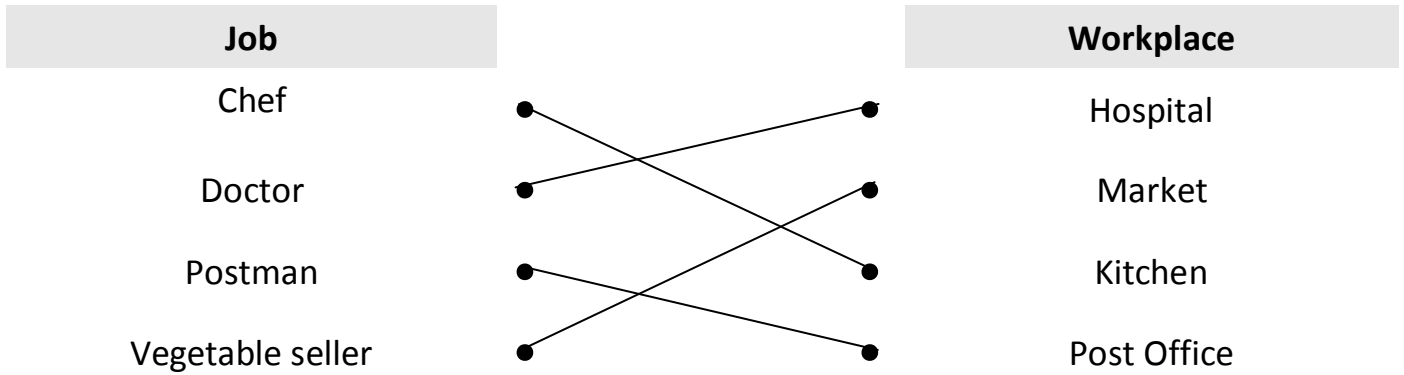

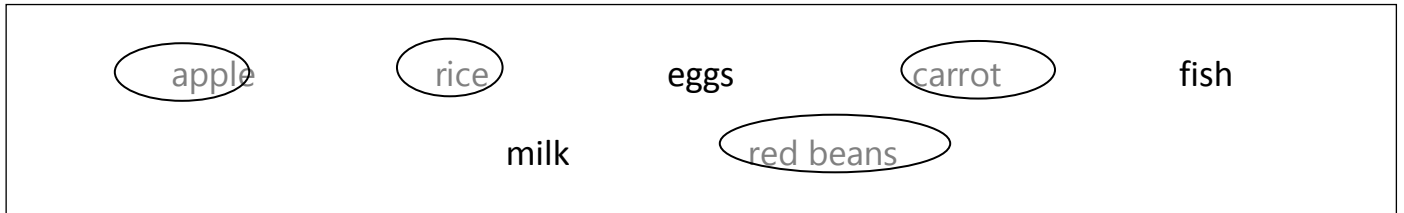
