August	Animal walk-zoo exercises Brain gym – midline crossing exercises: Bend to waist / Bend and touch toes Transition: Rhythmic clap and stamp	Develops gross and fine motor skill and spatial orientation Enhances body and mind coordination Enhances sensory skill Develops a sense of rhythm
September	Brain gym – vertical line crossing exercises :Draw long vertical line in the air Finger rhymes Transition: I-A-O Eurhythmy (I am a king and I am a queen)	Prepares children to read and write, increases attention span, develops fine motor skill
