July	Animal walk-zoo exercises <i>Transition: A-E-I-O-U Eurhythmy, I-A-O Eurhythmy (Tall as a tree I stand..)</i>	Develops gross and fine motor skill and spatial orientation, improves articulation of words
August	Giant and fairy walk (with the song “on the tip toes...”) <i>Transition: Rhythmic clap ‘work while you work....’</i>	Creates a sense of music and develops listening skill, prepares children to read and write
